'Where's Your Head At?' Campaign:

We have some exciting news to share on the 'Where's Your Head At?' campaign, which is calling on Government to change the law so that employers make First Aid provision for both the mental and physical health of their employees.

Mental health first aid to be debated in Parliament

Your support so far has ensured that the topic of mental health in the workplace cannot be ignored and has resulted in today's announcement that a parliamentary debate on mental health first aid in the workplace has been scheduled. This is currently due to take place next week in the House of Commons on Wednesday 19th December.

Sponsored by a cross-party trio of MPs, Luciana Berger MP (Lab), Norman Lamb MP (Lib Dem) and Johnny Mercer MP (Con), the debate follows 200,000 members of the public signing a petition to ask the government to make mental health first aid mandatory in the workplace. Shortly after a letter was sent to the Prime Minister, signed by over 50 senior leaders representing the business, education and mental health sectors – all calling on the government to uphold its 2017 manifesto pledge to change the law and put mental and physical first aid on an equal footing in the workplace.

Call on your MP to get involved

We need your help to ensure the debate is as impactful as possible. We need as many MPs as possible to attend and join in the debate, so please take five minutes today to contact your MP and ask them to attend the debate on Wednesday 19th December.

The key thing is to ensure as many MPs as possible are aware of this debate and understand its importance. So please take that into consideration when emailing them.
