- Treat all customers, volunteers and market staff with respect and kindness

What Makes a Great Volunteer Leader

- Strong leadership skills, including reliability, dedication, and conflict resolution skills
- Work well in teams and with other people.
- Must be comfortable using apps on a tablet
- Ability to work outdoors in the summer (rain or shine)
