
November 2023 compared with October 2023

Industrial production down by 0.3% in the euro area and by 0.2% in the EU

Down by 6.8% in the euro area and by 5.8% in the EU compared with November 2022

In November 2023, the seasonally adjusted industrial production decreased by 0.3% in the **euro area** and by 0.2% in the **EU**, compared with October 2023, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In October 2023, industrial production decreased by 0.7% in the **euro area** and by 0.5% in the **EU**.

In November 2023 compared with November 2022, industrial production decreased by 6.8% in the **euro area** and by 5.8% in the **EU**.



Monthly comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

Industrial production in the **euro area** in November 2023, compared with October 2023, fell by 2.0% for durable consumer goods, by 0.8% for capital goods and by 0.6% for intermediate goods, while production grew by 0.9% for energy and by 1.2% for non-durable consumer goods.

In the **EU**, industrial production fell by 1.8% for durable consumer goods, by 0.8% for capital goods and by 0.7% for intermediate goods, while production grew by 0.7% for energy and by 1.7% for non-durable consumer goods.


Among Member States for which data are available, the largest monthly decreases were registered in **Greece** (-4.1%), **Slovakia** (-4.0%) and **Belgium** (-3.8%). The highest increases were observed in **Denmark** (+9.1%), **Slovenia** (+3.7%) and **Portugal** (+3.4%).

Annual comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

Industrial production in the **euro area** in November 2023, compared with November 2022, fell by 10.3% for capital goods, by 8.0% for durable consumer goods, by 6.9% for non-durable consumer goods and by 5.2% for intermediate goods, while production grew by 0.8% for energy.

In the **EU**, industrial production fell by 8.7% for capital goods, by 8.4% for durable consumer goods, by 5.6% for intermediate goods and by 3.8% for non-durable consumer goods, while production grew by 1.0% for energy.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest annual decreases were registered in **Ireland** (-30.4%), **Belgium** (-11.6%) and **Bulgaria** (-10.9%). The highest increases were observed in **Denmark** (+14.4%), **Croatia** (+4.8%) and **Sweden** (+3.4%).



Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA20) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

Cyprus has a derogation with respect to Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 to have a longer deadline until the end of 2023.

Methods and definitions

The **index of industrial production** measures the evolution of the volume of production for industry excluding construction, based on data adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data.

Total industry covers NACE rev.2 sections B to D. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

Revisions and timetable

Compared with data issued in the News Release 137/2023 of 13 December 2023, the monthly percentage decrease for October 2023 remained unchanged at -0.7% in the euro area and at -0.5% in the EU. The annual percentage decrease remained unchanged at -6.6% in the euro area and has been revised from -5.5% to -5.4% in the EU.
