RJ Smith	 We were glad to publicly support people in an <u>open letter</u> As we said then we believe: people with Downs Syndrome should be heard on all decisions that affect them we support all efforts to make inclusion real

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	We want the laws and policy to support all people with learning disabilities to have good lives.
Cantolica Contractor	We do not understand how a separate law for people with Downs Syndrome that does not cover other people with learning disabilities will support inclusion and equal rights for everyone.
	We worry that separating people can lead to bad changes as well as good ones for some people.
People 1st	We believe people with Downs Syndrome should lead any decisions on this.
	We have talked about this as a Rep Body but not heard from Learning Disability England members as a whole yet. We are going to ask our members what they think about this idea.
	We will share what they tell us. We hope there can be more debate about this.
